

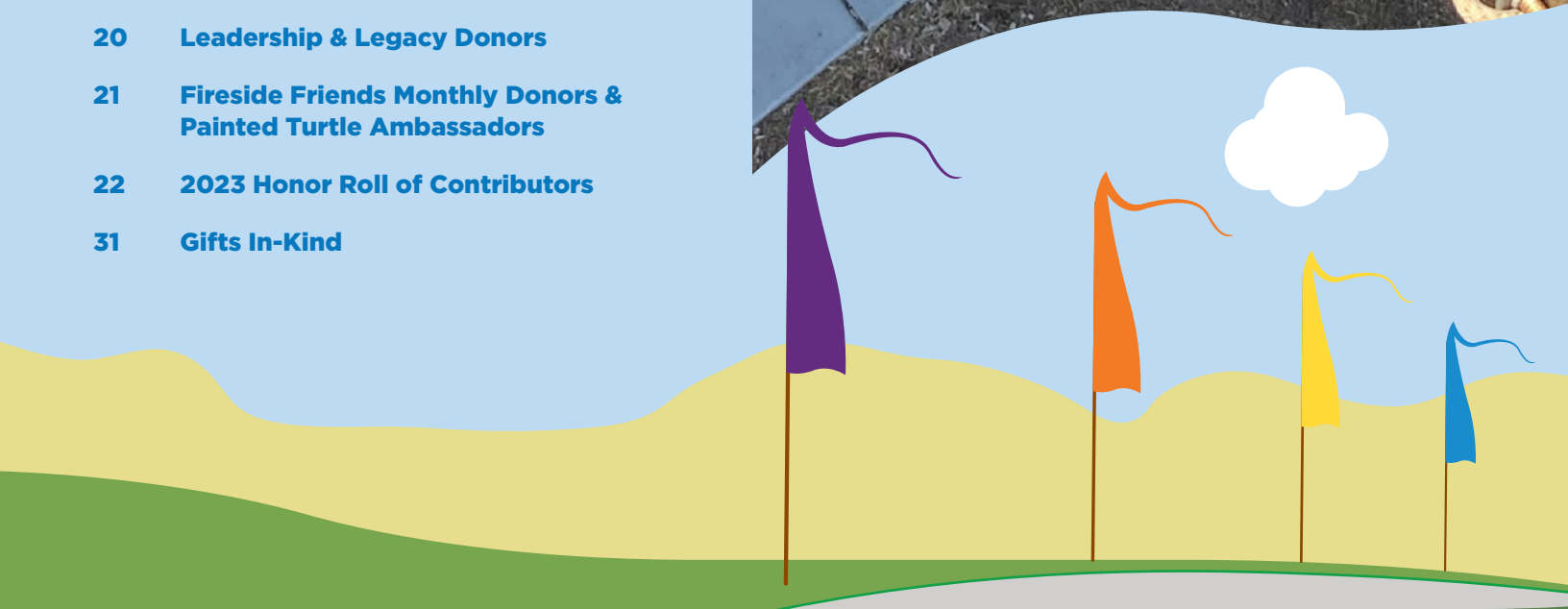

Dear Valued Friends and Trusted Partners,

As we reflect on another extraordinary year of creating a community of joy, courage, and belonging for children with serious medical issues, our hearts are full of gratitude for you and the countless number of donors, volunteers and supporters who help us bring The Painted Turtle mission to life each day.

2023 marked our return to a full year-round schedule of Family Weekends and Summer Sessions at our Lake Hughes campsite, while our Outpost Team brought the magic of Camp to hospitals across the state. Camp outcomes continued to demonstrate the positive impact that a Painted Turtle experience has on a camper’s sense of confidence, independence, and belonging with Summer Session surveys reporting that 95% of Campers tried at least one new thing, 93% said that Camp made them feel confident about who they are, and 91% felt like they belonged at The Painted Turtle.

Guided by a bold, new three-year Strategic Plan aimed at serving as many children with serious illnesses and their families as possible, we increased our reach this year for the third year in a row, while continuing to ensure that Camp is always free of charge. This year’s theme was, “Go Where You Wanna Go” and the stories and photos that follow encapsulate this spirit of individuality and “challenge by choice” that defines our Painted Turtle Camp sessions, where “kids get to be kids”, and in the words of our Founder Paul Newman, “raise a little hell.”



As we close out our second decade with this report, we are inspired by the limitless possibilities of what we can accomplish together in our 20th year and beyond. We are grateful for every hour you volunteered, every gift you gave, and every bit of support you provided in 2023. Because of you, our future looks brighter than ever.

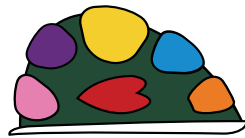


Our Mission & Core Values

Camp: Here, There, Everywhere - All Year Long



Driven by our vision to bring the magic of The Painted Turtle to as many as possible, we increased our reach in 2023 by +23% through transformative Camp experiences at our Lake Hughes campsite, in Camper homes, in hospitals, and across our communities. In total, we provided over 43,000 Camp experiences, the highest number since we opened our gates two decades ago. The program breakdown below is a celebration of how our remarkable staff and volunteers touched the hearts and spirits of children everywhere, while ensuring that The Painted Turtle, in all its forms, is always free of charge.



1,026 In-Person Camp Experiences

Based on the success of our 2022 post-pandemic safety protocols, we resumed a full schedule of year-round, in-person camp experiences in 2023, at 80% capacity. Ever mindful of the continued CDC and LA County COVID guidelines to ensure maximum safety for all who entered our gates, we successfully delivered 1,026 camp experiences to children, siblings, and caregivers, an increase of +31% over 2022. Onsite programming included 8 Family Weekends, 7 weeklong Summer Sessions and our annual Holiday Gathering. We also expanded leadership program opportunities for 17 and 18-year-old former campers and hosted our third Campamento para Familias, a Family Weekend conducted entirely in Spanish.



82 Camp at Home Experiences

A virtual Family Camp at Home Day continued to provide an online Camp at Home option in 2023 for children and families who were not ready to return to in-person Camp. This engaging, interactive in-home Camp experience brought the whole family together for Painted Turtle favorites like Stage Day, Cabin Chats, and even a virtual Campfire, ensuring we stayed connected to our camper families from the comfort of their own homes.





41,661 Outpost Experiences

2023 was a record setting year for The Painted Turtle's Outpost In-Hospital program as we made a full return to in-person Camp experiences at 21 hospitals across California. In all, Outpost delivered 168 in-hospital visits, serving 41,661 children with serious illnesses and their families, an increase of +24% over 2022! As our team touched the lives of children who were hospitalized through playrooms, bedside visits, activity bags and Turtle-Grams, they also provided support and respite to parents and caregivers who were present during these visits.



694 Community Camp Experiences

Our team nearly doubled the number of community events we attended in 2023, bringing the wonder and excitement of The Painted Turtle to health and wellness fairs, athletic events and holiday parties across the state. Energetic Painted Turtle staff and volunteers packed up Camp Vans with games, arts and crafts and a whole lotta Painted Turtle love as we brought the joy and magic of Camp directly to our communities.



On the Road Again With Our Outpost Hospital Program



The Painted Turtle Outpost, our Hospital Outreach program, made a full return to in-person visits in 2023 to hospitals across California, including the Bay Area and San Diego, which had been put on pause for the past three years due to COVID restrictions. In all, Outpost delivered a record-setting 168 in-person visits, serving 41,661 children with serious illnesses and their families, an increase of +24% from 2022.

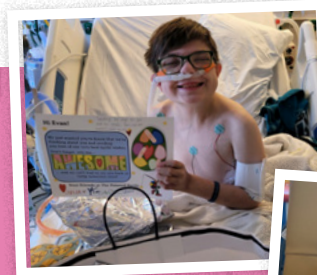

A magic moment to share: During a visit at UCSF Benioff Children’s Hospital in San Francisco a Pulmonary Hypertension camper and her family joined us in the playroom. She had been in the hospital for several weeks, and this was her first time down in the playroom and it was a pleasant surprise for her to see familiar faces. Her parents told us her care team was having a tough time getting her to take part in different therapies and this was the first time during this hospitalization she was willing to participate on her own. She requested that we do some Camp dancing, and she joined us in running through the whole Spotify Painted Turtle Dance Playlist. The music therapist, who was also in the playroom, was in awe that she was singing and dancing and asked us to share the songs with her to use in her own sessions with the camper since it was such a hit. Sometimes it just takes some familiar faces and activities to spark fond memories and turn a rough hospitalization around.

A Haven of Hope: Our Painted Turtle Experience

When our son Yossarian was first diagnosed with Adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), he was only a month old. The diagnosis has been incredibly isolating, and in many ways has defined our journey as first-time parents. We searched for a sense of community amongst other ALD caregivers and patients which we fortunately found. For us that looked like monthly community support calls and medical conferences, but Painted Turtle Camp has offered something more.

Driving the winding road to Lake Hughes for the first time, we felt a sense of excitement and trepidation. We were not sure what to expect; after all, our son was young and very shy around new people. When we arrived at camp we were awestruck; it was beautiful, peaceful, and we were humbled by this opportunity to spend the weekend here.

Our Yossarian, like most ALD boys, has adrenal insufficiency and requires an injection in the event of a crisis, a constant worry for us. During check-in at the Well Shell, Camp's medical facility, the nurses and medical team gave us a renewed peace of mind that we had forgotten we had the capacity to feel.

We entered the Dining Hall and I saw some familiar faces from our community calls and conferences. But there was also the buzz of young counselors, kids playing, laughing, and everyone dancing to music. PUN, a long-time volunteer, immediately found Yossarian a huge bubble wand and Yossarian gleefully took the bubble wand and wielded it around like his wizard staff. Within minutes of entering the lively Dining Hall it seemed like Yossarian knew these were his people, and our shy, anxious little boy was strutting around Camp like he owned the place.

There was a big influx of counselors from Barretstown, The Painted Turtle's Sister Camp in Ireland, and our assigned counselor, Rachel (who aspires to work in the Child Life field) really connected with Yossarian. He felt so safe with her, and it made our world feel a little less small to meet people from across the world who wanted to spend their summer with us.



We had several counselors assigned to our family; many were former campers themselves with their own conditions. Watching Yossarian connect with them was a moving and healing experience.

I expected to connect with the other families, and that was indeed wonderful to be together in a space that was just about having fun. There is nothing like being around other families with your same medical diagnosis who just get it. But what really surprised me was the capability of The Painted Turtle team, the Well Shell medical staff, and the cabin counselors. The walls we put up over the previous year and half came down over this magical weekend. Our Painted Turtle experience was a reminder of how much good there is in this world, and for those of us navigating these difficult medical conditions, that we are not alone.

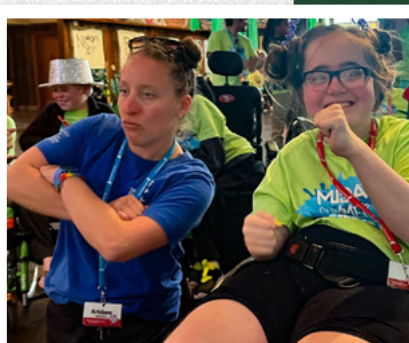

“ One of the most poignant memories I hold dear from my time at The Painted Turtle revolves around a young camper’s first day at the age of nine. It was not just his first day at Camp -- but also his first time being away from home -- compounded by the difficulties of managing his medical needs, particularly his oxygen requirements.

As we navigated the ropes course together, it took some time to ensure he was safely harnessed in and felt confident enough to proceed. However, the moment he completed the course remains etched in my memory forever. His face lit up with sheer joy and newfound confidence, tears welling in his eyes as he glanced back at me. It was a transformative moment, emblematic of the growth and empowerment that many campers experience at The Painted Turtle.

Year after year, he returned to Camp until he aged out. His journey mirrors that of countless others who have found growth, and healing within our Camp’s welcoming embrace. Witnessing these transformations, whether it’s through shared scars that forge instant connections or the profound impact of a camper-turned-author sharing her story with the entire Camp, is nothing short of extraordinary.

The relationships formed at The Painted Turtle extend far beyond the confines of Camp, bridging the gap between campers and staff in meaningful and enduring ways. Personally, I’ve had the privilege of mentoring campers and watching them blossom into confident, resilient individuals. The bonds forged here are not fleeting; they are the foundation upon which lifelong friendships are built.”

2023 Campsite Update



Protecting and enhancing our 20-year-old Painted Turtle campsite is a key component in our 2023-2025 Strategic Plan, ensuring campers will continue to experience a safe, inclusive, and nurturing environment where they can create lifelong Painted Turtle Camp memories. In 2023, we developed a comprehensive master plan for proactive site maintenance and enhancements to maximize accessibility, safety, and future growth. We also convened a site committee comprised of staff, Board members, and volunteers to provide oversight of the plan as we move into our third decade.

New Additions at Camp



12-Passenger Camper Van

New 12-passenger Camper Van—In response to the growing demand for transportation services to and from The Painted Turtle, a new 12-passenger van increased transportation options for Campers who come from across California.

10 Golf Carts



Golf Cart Fleet Additions—Ten new golf carts were added to our fleet in 2023, including four 8-passenger carts, five 4-passenger carts, and one 6-passenger cart. These versatile vehicles enhanced site mobility, safety and accessibility.

Kitchen Dishwasher

Industrial Strength Kitchen Dishwasher—Enhanced kitchen cleanliness and hygiene standards and streamlined food service operations thanks to a dedicated long-time volunteer and donor.

Kitchen Icemaker

Large Capacity Kitchen Icemaker—Increased ability to meet hydration and refreshment needs, keeping Campers, Volunteers and Staff cool during the warmer months.

Landscaping Truck—Helped strengthen capabilities to efficiently transport landscaping materials, equipment, and team members across Camp.



Our Medical Dream Team - Making the Dream of Camp a Reality

As we welcomed back campers in 2023 to our first full schedule of sessions since the pandemic began, we also welcomed back an increasing number of medical volunteers who returned to share their knowledge, ability, time, and excellent care for our campers. Medical professionals came from across California and included physicians, nurses, respiratory therapists, occupational therapists, and physical therapists from specialty areas like Nephrology, Dialysis, Endocrinology, Neurology, Hematology, Gastroenterology, and parenteral nutrition.

While keeping our campers safe during each session, Camp creates an opportunity for our medical volunteers to care for the same children they treat in their hospitals and clinics during the year in a fun, casual, and engaging Camp atmosphere where children’s true personalities really shine through. We couldn’t be more grateful to have them on the Well Shell Team!



Why Our Medical Team Keeps Coming Back

In 2023, The Painted Turtle was part of a national research study in collaboration with The University of Colorado that revealed that volunteering at Camp greatly influences a medical provider’s personal and professional perspective for practicing medicine.

Findings showed that medical volunteers:

- Felt included, a sense of purpose, and developed strong connections.
- Compassion fatigue scores were lower and were sustained.
- Felt respite, value, sense of purpose, and a joy in medicine.

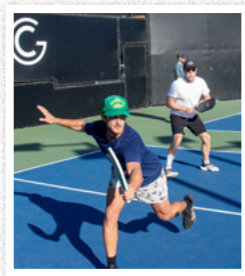

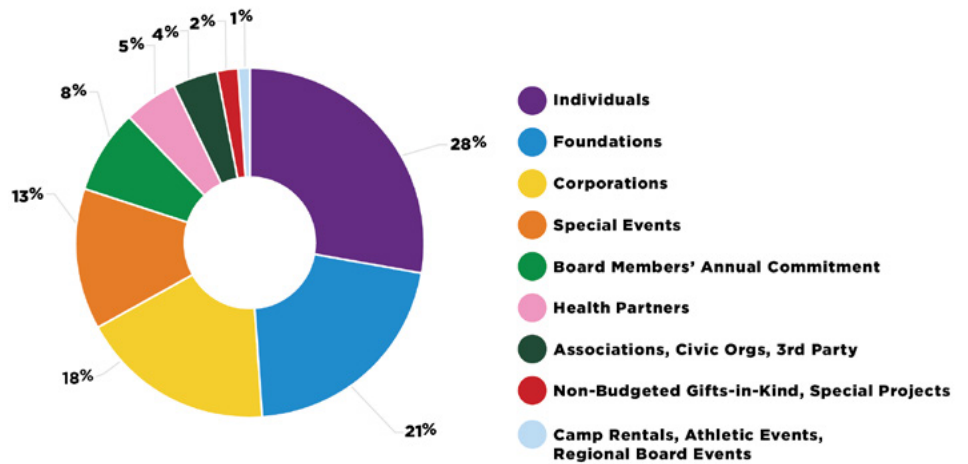

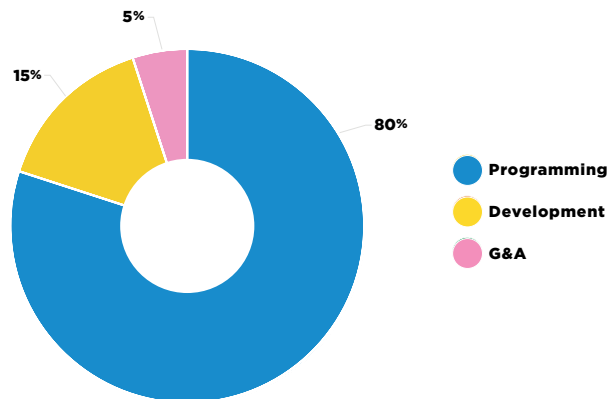
